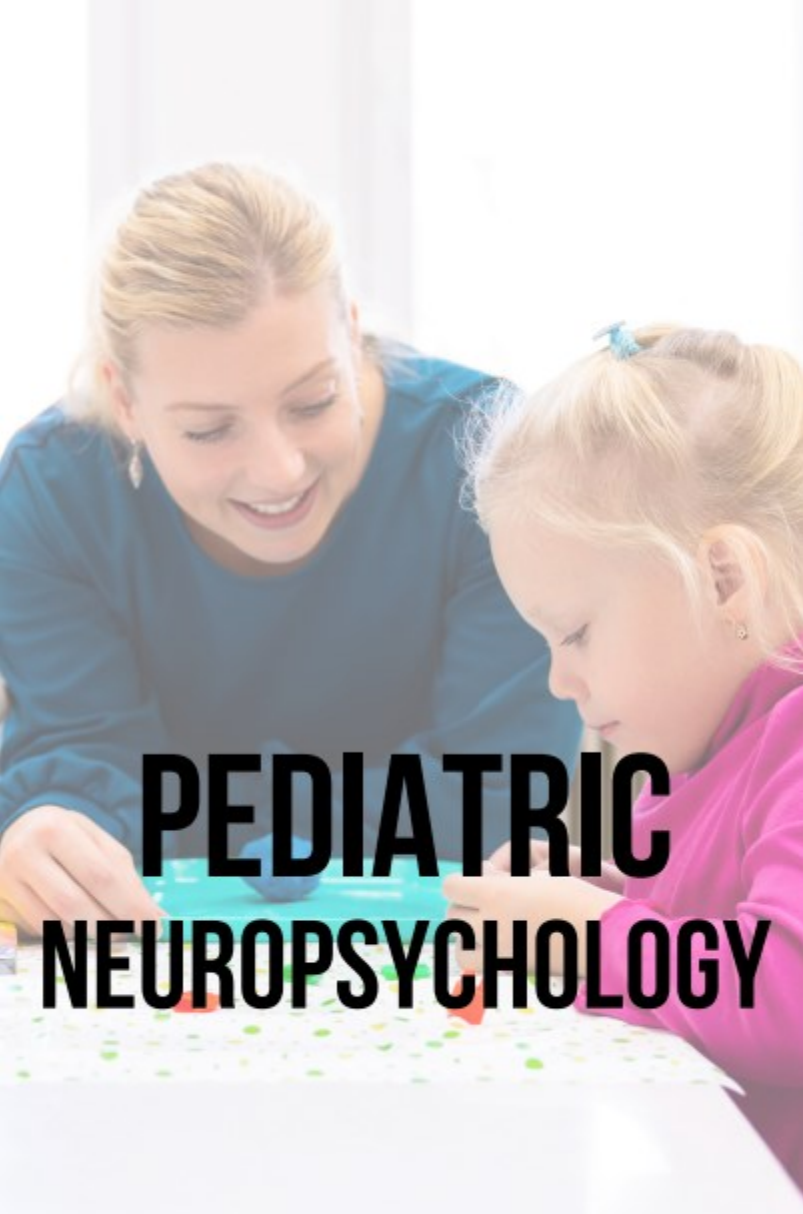

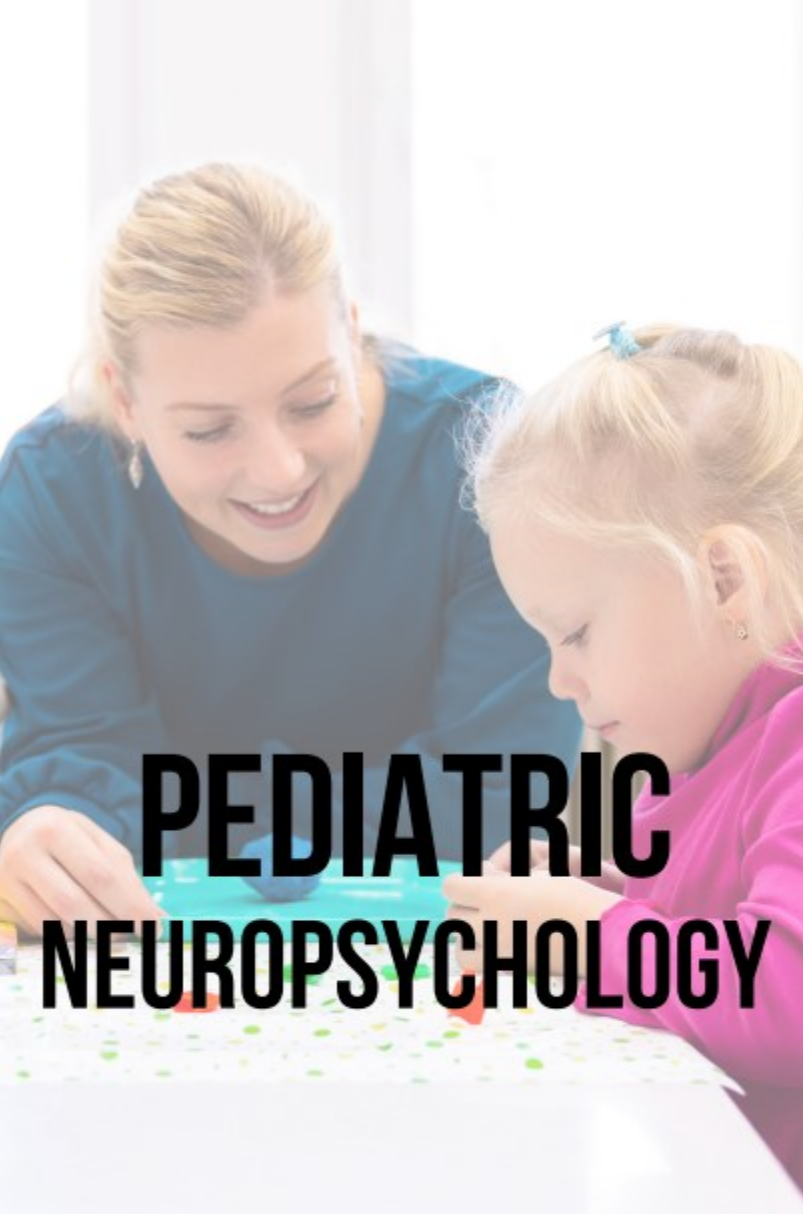

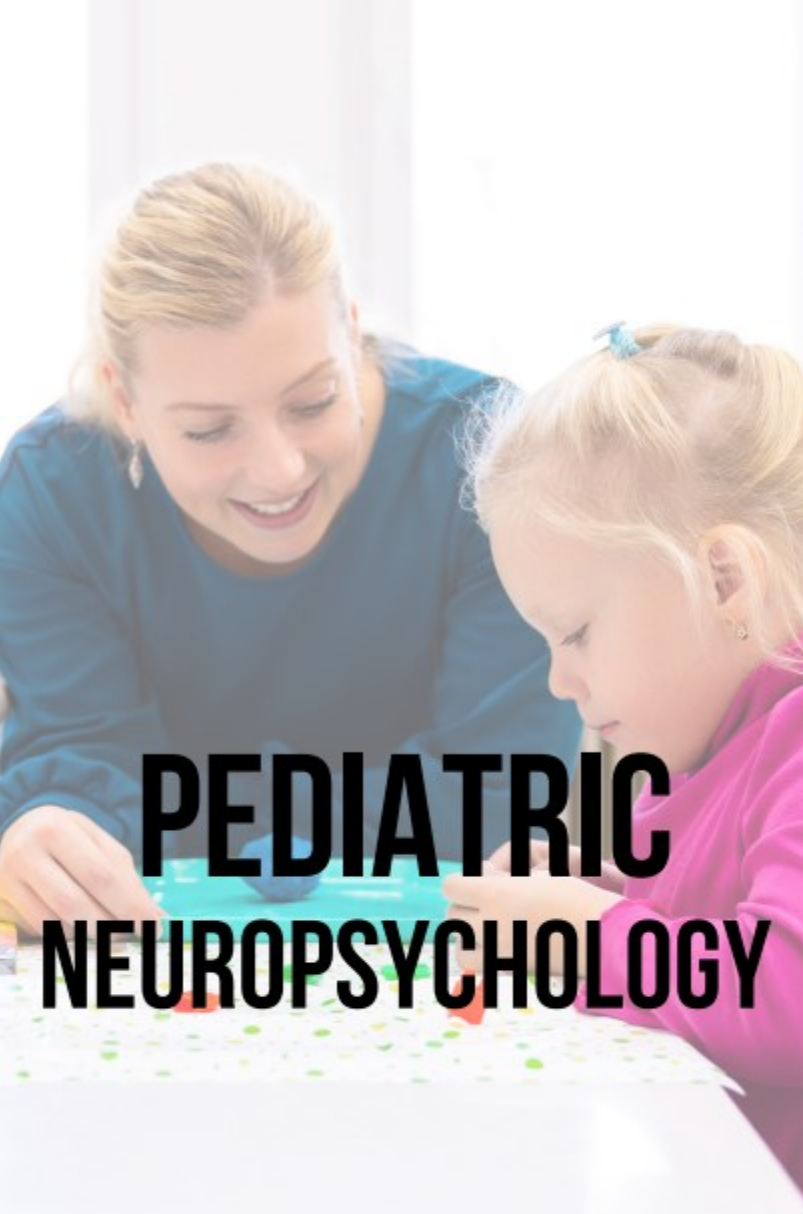

TONGUE TIE RELEASE PROVIDERS

What do they do?

Tongue tie release providers perform a procedure called a frenotomy to release a restrictive band of tissue (lingual frenulum) that connects the bottom of the tongue to the floor of the mouth. This can interfere with a baby's ability to properly latch onto the breast or bottle, and can also cause speech difficulties in older children. The procedure is typically a quick and simple one, done with scissors or a laser, and can often be done in an outpatient setting.



OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

What do they do?

Pediatric occupational therapy helps children gain independence while also strengthening the development of fine motor skills, sensory-motor skills, and visual motor skills that children need to function and socialize.

OTs help children perform daily activities they may find challenging by addressing sensory, social, behavioral, motor, and environmental issues.

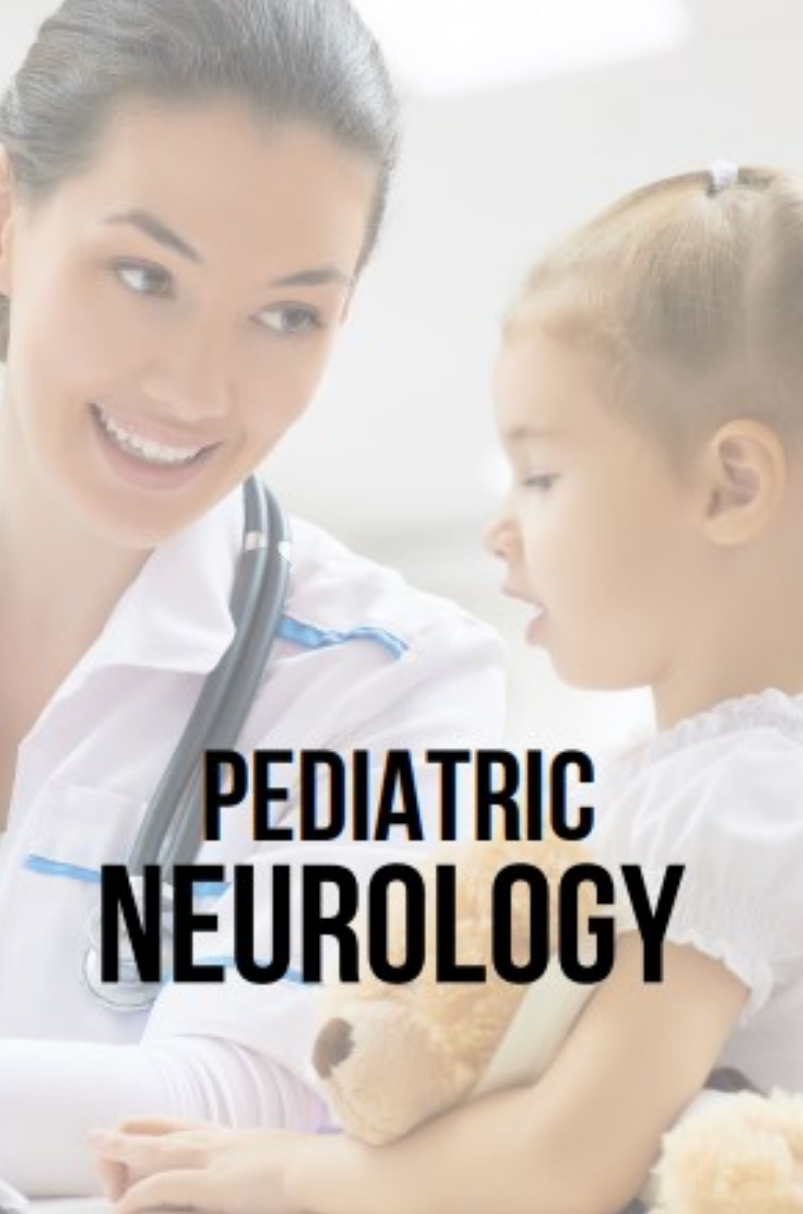

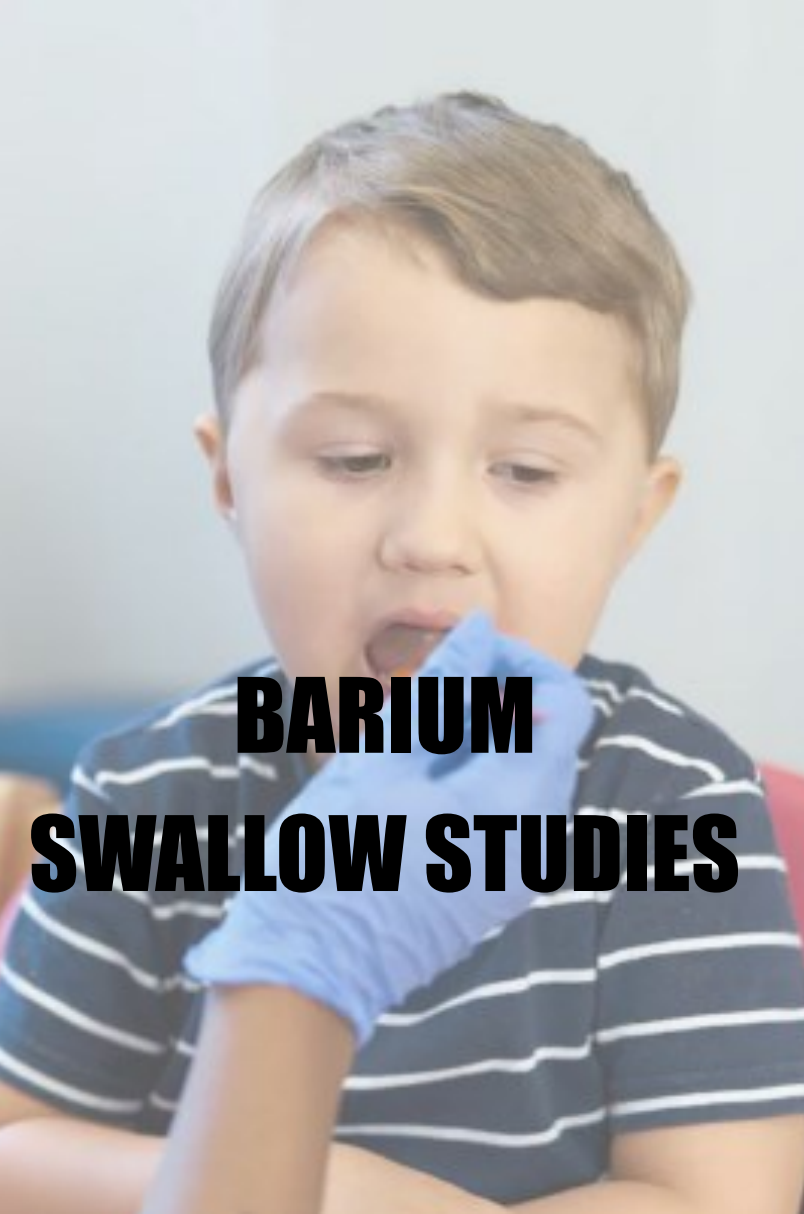

What do they do?

Your therapist or physician may recommend a barium swallow study to rule out conditions such as aspiration or other swallowing difficulties. A barium swallow, also known as an esophagogram or swallowing study, is a noninvasive imaging test that uses X-rays and barium to examine the upper gastrointestinal (GI) tract for problems. The test can help diagnose issues with swallowing or reflux, as well as physical abnormalities in the throat and esophagus.

During the study, the patient drinks a chalky-tasting liquid that contains barium, which makes certain parts of the body show up more clearly on an X-ray. A radiologist then uses a special type of X-ray called fluoroscopy to observe the barium moving through the upper GI tract in real time as the patient swallows. The radiologist may also ask the patient to turn into different positions while taking pictures. A barium swallow usually takes between 30 minutes and two hours and is usually
